The Symbols of the Wedding Ceremony

The Wedding Rings: Blessing the wedding rings and presenting them to the bride and groom is a symbol of the covenant sealed between them, so that "they shall rejoice and sing glory to God!" The Crowns: After receiving the blessing and wearing the covenant rings, the bride and groom wear the crowns of glory and dignity. The crowns symbolize the Lord's blessing of their union through which He grants them the grace to contribute to His heavenly work; the Creation.
